Buckland Housing Need Survey - Executive Summary

Buckland Parish Council recently commissioned Gloucestershire Rural Community Council to undertake a Housing Need Survey in order to ascertain the affordable housing needs within the Parish. Housing Need Surveys were sent to 126 households and 34 (27%) replies were returned to GRCC. 2 of the respondents said it was their second home. Analysis of the data from the 32 households living in Buckland revealed that:

- 91% of respondents owned their own home, 6% rented from a private landlord and 3% stated 'another' tenure.
- 75% of homes have 3 or more bedrooms. Yet 84% of households had only 1 or 2 persons.
- One respondent revealed that a member of their family had moved away in the last 5 years because they could not afford the accommodation available within the parish.
- There are currently 2 households within the parish who have self-identified themselves as being in need of affordable housing.
- 19% of respondents were in favour of a small development of affordable homes, 50% were against, and 31% were a 'maybe'.
